"If I crash into someone else's car, I can claim on the 3rd part insurance that I pay as part of my Driver's Licence right"?

Wrong... The 3rd party insurance that you pay as part of your driver's license will only cover injuries to others, not vehicle or property damage you may cause.

So if you hit another vehicle out on the roads, the insurance that you pay as part of your driver's license will cover any injuries, but you may be responsible for any damage caused to the other car.

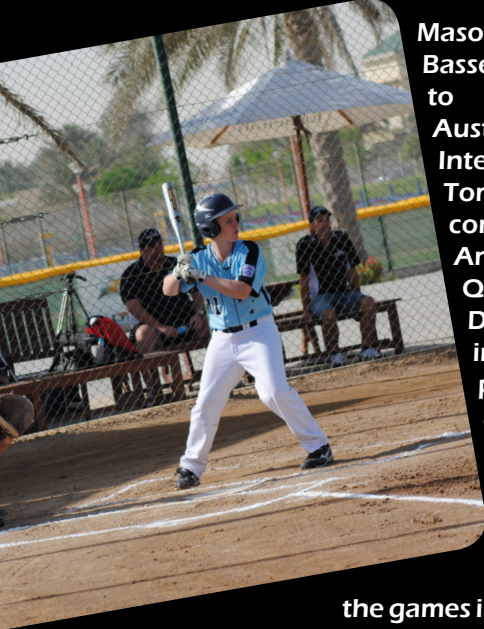
Worth thinking about if you are tailgating a Mercedes. For an 18 year old male, driving a 10 year old Commodore, 3rd party property insurance costs around \$400 per year. That ends up being pretty cheap compared to writing off someone else's \$40000 car.

This type of insurance becomes void though if you are under the influence of drugs/alcohol or your license has been suspended.



Dudley Robinson Youth Grant

The Dudley Robinson Youth Grant supports individuals to strive toward developing their potential in their chosen pursuit. Recently the Town of Bassendean awarded the Dudley Robinson Youth Grant to two young people from Bassendean.



Mason Talbon from Bassendean went to Dubai to represent Western Australian at the Dubia International Little League Tournament, where he completed against Saudi Arabia, Bahrain and Qatar. On the way to Dubai the team stopped in Hong Kong and played against Japan and the Hong Kong school team, and then against the Hong Kong all-stars.

Mason said "most of the games in the Dubai tournament were very close but in the end our team won the tournament."

Levi Ridley also received the Dudley Robinson Youth Grant which helped him get to Adelaide to play in the State School Boys Football League.

Individuals can apply for a grant to represent the State or Commonwealth in a recognised sporting, performance arts, academic achievement event, or to attend youth leadership activities.

The grant will provide up to \$300 for international representation and \$200 for National representation. For Youth Leadership Activities the limit is set at \$250.

To be eligible you must live in the Town of Bassendean and be aged between 12 and 25 years.

Bassendean Youth Services

Bassendean Youth Services are situated underneath the McDonald Pavilion at Steel Blue Oval on the corner of West and Guildford Roads near the Skate Park.

The Youth Centre is open for young people to 'drop-in' between 3pm and 6pm Tuesday to Friday, and offers a broadband internet and computer game café, XBOX, band room, and DVD movie projector. Everything happening in the afternoons is free, and the centre is available for young people aged 12 to 25.

The centre also runs LAN parties, band rehearsals and activities most weeks. Saturday activities are also offered every couple of months. In the past activities have included: Adventure World, Go-Karting, Outdoor Rock Climbing, and Paintballing. Most of these activities only cost a few dollars per person.
